The harbor in Mazatlan is the meeting point for the Sea of Cortez and Pacific Ocean and is known world-wide for its tuna and shrimp production. Optional shore excursions here range from a walking tour of the village and hike to its iconic lighthouse to a nature excursion and plantation canopy adventure. (All meals onboard)

DAY SEVEN - Cabo San Lucas, Baja Peninsula

Located at the tip of the Baja Peninsula's "Land's End" sits its crown jewel, Cabo San Lucas. Famous for its world-class sportfishing, high-end resorts and exclusive gated communities, Cabo San Lucas is highlighted by its signature landmark



El Arco, ("The Arch") rock formation. Whale watching, snor-keling and touring along the peninsula are all optional excursions offered here. (All meals onboard)


DAY NINE - Travel Home
