DAYS ONE AND TWO – Depart for Florida

DAY THREE – Arrive in St Augustine

Arrive on Florida's beautiful Palm Coast in America's oldest city, St Augustine. Founded by Pedro Menendez de Aviles in 1565, St. Augustine is a unique city filled with colonial Spanish neighborhoods, magnificent buildings and a charm all its own. After some free time

DAY FOUR – Trolley Tour and British Night Watch Parade

Begin the day with a narrated trolley tour of historic St. Augustine which highlights the city's exciting past. See the Fernando-Lambias House, built in 1763 and pass Castillo de San Marcos, the Spanish fortress which dominates the beautiful bay. Next, relics of America's Gilded Age are elegantly exhibited at the Lightner Museum which includes Victorian art glass and the stained glass work of Louis Comfort Tiffany. Later we join the masses at Government House where we welcome the British Redcoats in their British Night Watch Grande Illumination Parade complete with firing muskets and joyful Christmas Caroling. DAY FIVE – Villa Zorayda and Garden Club's Tour of Homes

We pay a visit to the Villa Zorayda Museum, a National Register Historic Site with its incredible collection of artifacts, before boarding our vessel, the *Victory III* for a relaxing cruise of Matanzas Bay. Enjoy the shipping and waterfront tales of the early days, take in the beauty of the red-tiled city roofs and maybe even catch sight of the many dolphins and manatees which inhabit the bay. At the Columbia Restaurant, we enjoy award-winning Spanish/Cuban cuisine surrounded by hand-painted tiles and Spanish-style fountains. Then, join the Garden Club of St. Augustine for their beautiful Tour of Homes. Visit 6 private homes dating from the 1800s exquisitely decorated with wreaths, garlands and an included afternoon tea featuring homemade treats. [\(Breakfast and lunch\)](#)
