## DAY TWO – Eclipse Day at Beachaven Winery

Eclipse day begins at the Customs House Museum which was built in 1898 as a Post Office and Customs House to handle the mail generated by the city's international tobacco business. Today the museum is dedicated to collect, preserve and interpret the region's history. We will be joined by an expert from the Austin Peay State University's Astronomy Club who will explain what we will see during the solar eclipse. With our knowledge in hand, we then travel to Beachaven Vineyards and Winery for a special "Eclipse at

the Beach" party. For over 30 years, Beachaven has been producing critically-acclaimed wines. There will be an included lunch, live music, protective eye wear as well as an expert to answer any question about this historic event. Later, we visit the Southern Lights Tobacco Farm where we'll meet the farmer, learn about the farming process and hear about tobacco's impact on the local economy.
