DAY THREE – Mackinac Island

Today we ferry to Mackinac Island, where the charm of a bygone era is preserved. No automobiles are permitted and nothing intrudes on the serenity and natural beauty of the Island. Tour via horse-drawn carriage and then arrive at the crown jewel of Mackinac Island, The Grand Hotel, the world's largest summer hotel, built in 1887 and our home for the next two nights.
